## Vehicle Laws - Rules of the Road

This bill conforms provisions of the Maryland Vehicle Law to the Uniform Vehicle Law by clarifying and repealing certain language. The bill also requires the State Highway Administration to install and maintain residential handicapped parking space signs that conform to the Maryland accessibility code. Additionally, the bill prohibits the sale or installation of certain traffic control devices unless the devices conform to certain specifications.
