Senate Bill 405 (Senator Conway)

Budget and Taxation

Creation of a State Debt - Baltimore City - Epiphany House

This bill provides \$150,000 in State bond proceeds as a grant to the Board of Directors of Govans Ecumenical Development Corporation for the repair, renovation, capital equipping, furnishing, and landscaping of the Epiphany House, located in the Govans community of Baltimore City.

The Board of Directors must provide matching funds by June 1, 2000. The matching fund may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective date of the bill. No portion of the grant proceeds may be used to further sectarian religious purposes.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: This \$150,000 grant would be part of the total \$430 million general obligation debt authorization for FY 1999 as recommended by the Capital Debt Affordability Committee. State debt service costs on the \$430 million would be a maximum of \$44.2 million annually based on the 4.34% interest rate realized at the February 18, 1998 bond sale.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: Minimal.
