Appropriations

State Retirement and Pension System - Board of Trustees - Membership

This bill alters the eligibility requirements for membership on the Board of Trustees of the Maryland State Retirement and Pension System (MSRPS). The bill requires that one of the two trustees who represent members and retirees of the various State employee retirement and pension systems must be a retiree. Current law requires that only one of those two trustees may be a retiree. Similarly, one of the two trustees who represent teachers' system members and retirees must be a retiree, while current law requires that only one of those two trustees may be a retiree.
