## Fire Departments - Privatization - Referendum Required

This bill prohibits a county or municipality from privatizing fire, emergency medical, paramedic, or rescue services unless an enactment to that effect is submitted to referendum and is passed by a majority of voters in the county or municipality during a general or special election. Currently there are no privatized fire, emergency medical, paramedic, or rescue services in the State of Maryland.

This bill is effective July 1, 1998.

## **Fiscal Summary**

**Local Effect:** None. Should a county or municipality seek to privatize these services, any costs associated with a referendum could be handled with existing resources of local boards of election.
