**Alcoholic Beverages - Permits and Licenses**

---

This bill prohibits the Comptroller's Office from issuing a nonresident dealer's alcoholic beverages permit to a licensed wholesaler or retailer, or to a person with an interest in a licensed wholesaler or retailer, other than a disclosed legal, equity, or security interest of a malt beverage wholesaler. The bill also repeals a provision of law which allows a holder of a wholesale license to obtain one alcoholic beverages retailer license.
