## Estates and Trusts - Conversion of Sole Proprietorships to Limited Liability Companies by Personal Representatives and Fiduciaries

This bill gives a personal representative of an estate or the fiduciary of a trust the authority to convert the sole proprietorship of a decedent to a limited liability company.

#### **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** Potential minimal increase in revenues. Expenditures would not be affected.

Local Effect: None.

**Small Business Effect:** Minimal impact on small businesses.

#### **Fiscal Analysis**

**State Revenues:** Revenues would increase to the extent that a personal representative or fiduciary files articles of organization for a limited liability company with the Department of Assessments and Taxation and pays a \$50 filing fee. Any increase in revenues is assumed to be minimal.
