#### Task Force on Retirement Benefits of State and Local Law Enforcement Officers

This joint resolution requests the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House to establish a 15-member task force to study retirement benefits of State and local law enforcement officers. The task force would consist of members of the General Assembly and representatives from the executive branch and local governments. The Department of Legislative Services would provide staff support. The task force must make a final report to the Governor and the General Assembly by December 1, 1998.
