## Mass Transit Administration - Future Extension of Mass Transit Systems to St. Mary's County

This bill requires the Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) to study the feasibility of preserving or requiring the rights-of-way for a future mass transit extension from Charles County to St. Mary's County. MDOT must: (1) identify the property that will be needed for future extension; and (2) estimate the cost for the State to purchase the necessary rights-of-way. MDOT must solicit input for the study from the St. Mary's County Commissioners, utility companies, and other affected citizens. MDOT must report its findings and recommendations to the General Assembly by January 1, 1999. The bill is effective June 1, 1998.
