Budget and Taxation

Baltimore City - Property Tax Credit - Northwest Family Sport Center, Inc.

This bill allows Baltimore City to grant a tax credit against county property taxes imposed on the personal property owned by the Northwest Family Sport Center, Inc.

This bill is effective July 1, 1998.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Potential minimal decrease in Baltimore City revenues beginning in FY 1999. Expenditures would not be affected.

Small Business Effect: Potential meaningful impact for the Northwest Family Sport Center, Inc. If Baltimore City chooses to grant this property tax credit, the Northwest Family Sport Center, Inc. would realize an annual property tax savings of approximately \$6,600.

Fiscal Analysis

Local Revenues: The fiscal 1997 personal property assessment for the Northwest Family Sport Center, Inc. is approximately \$114,000. If Baltimore City chooses to grant the personal property tax credit authorized by this bill, revenues would decrease by approximately \$6,600 annually beginning in fiscal 1999 based on Baltimore City's property tax rate of \$5.85 per \$100 of assessed value.
