## **Forest Conservation - Exemptions**

This bill provides an additional exemption to the requirements of the Forest Conservation Act. The bill exempts any activity provided that: (1) the activity is conducted on land that is located in a locally designated growth area; (2) the activity is conducted on land that is served by public or community sewer or water systems; (3) the activity does not result in the cutting, clearing, or grading of more than 40,000 square feet of forest; and (4) for any cutting, clearing, or grading of up to 40,000 square feet of forest, the developer submits a statement to the Department of Natural Resources or local authority signed by a licensed engineer or surveyor that indicates the area of forest disturbance.

## **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** None. The bill would not materially alter State operations or finances.

**Local Effect:** Some local governments could have to amend local forest conservation ordinances to comply with the bill. It is estimated that any additional workload could be handled with existing resources.

**Small Business Effect:** Minimal.
