### FISCAL NOTE Revised

Senate Bill 626 (Senators Haines and Ferguson) (Carroll County Senators)

#### **Election Code - Carroll County Election Board - Salaries**

This bill provides that the annual salary of a member of the Carroll County Board of Supervisors of Elections must be at least \$3,000. Current law requires that members of the board receive a minimum annual salary of \$800. Any change in salaries would apply to the beginning of the next term of office.

### **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** None.

**Local Effect:** Carroll County expenditures would increase by \$2,025 beginning in FY 2002 and each year thereafter. No effect on revenues.

**Small Business Effect:** None.

# **Fiscal Analysis**

**Local Effect:** There are three members of the Carroll County Election Board who are appointed for four-year terms. The current annual salary of a board member is \$2,500. This bill provides for a minimum \$3,000 salary. Assuming that all board members will receive the minimum salary, Carroll County expenditures would increase by \$2,025 annually beginning with the next term of office in 2002. This estimate reflects an increase in salaries and fringe benefits for a full year.
