Senate Bill 497 (Senators Derr and Ferguson)

Budget and Taxation

Creation of a State Debt - Frederick County - Burgess and Commissioners of Middletown - Community Facility

This bill provides \$350,000 in State bond proceeds as a grant to the Burgess and Commissioners of the Town of Middletown for the repair, renovation, reconstruction, and capital equipping of a building at 29-31 West Main Street in Middletown to be used as a community center and offices for community agencies and organizations and town offices.

The Town of Middletown must provide matching funds by June 1, 2000.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: This \$350,000 grant would be part of the total \$430 million general obligation debt authorization for FY 1999 as recommended by the Capital Debt Affordability Committee. State debt service costs on the \$430 million would be a maximum of \$44.2 million annually based on the 4.34% interest rate realized at the February 18, 1998 bond sale.

Local Effect: City of Middletown grant revenue will increase by \$350,000 and expenditures will increase by \$700,000.

Small Business Effect: Minimal.
