**Environmental Matters** 

Office on Aging - Interagency Committee on Aging Services - Powers and Duties

This departmental bill requires the Chairman of the Interagency Committee on Aging Services (the director of the Office on Aging) to designate at least one meeting each year as an executive meeting and authorizes committee members to designate representatives to attend non-executive committee meetings.

## **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** None. The bill does not substantively change State activities or operations.

Local Effect: None.

**Small Business Effect:** The Office on Aging has determined that this bill has minimal or no impact on small businesses (attached). Legislative Services concurs with this assessment.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

**State Expenditures**: The bill clarifies whether an agency head or a designee may attend meetings but does not affect the number or location of meetings. Designation of a meeting of the Interagency Committee on Aging Services as an executive meeting would require a committee member who is a State department secretary or State agency director to attend (as opposed to a designee).
