## **Tobacco Products - Purchase by Minors - Prohibition**

This bill prohibits the purchase of tobacco products or cigarette rolling papers by a minor unless the minor is acting as the agent of his/her employer within the scope of employment.

## **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** Any effect on tobacco tax revenues is assumed to be minimal. Any increase in the Judiciary's caseload resulting from an increased number of complaints requiring court action is not expected to affect the Judiciary's finances.

**Local Effect:** None. Any additional circuit court workload resulting from this bill could be handled within existing resources. Enforcement could be handled with existing resources.

Small Business Effect: None.
