Commerce and Government Matters

Vehicle Laws - Agents of Manufacturers and Distributors - Prohibition on Retail Sales

This bill adds limited liability companies and limited liability partnerships that are owned or controlled by or under common control with a manufacturer or distributer to the types of business entities that are prohibited from selling new vehicles to retail buyers.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. The bill does not directly affect State finances or operations.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: Potential meaningful. Limited liability companies and partnerships that are associated with manufacturers or distributors and that sell new vehicles to retail buyers would have a competitive advantage over other vehicle dealers because they would have direct access to the products at a lower cost. The bill maintains the competitive balance among dealers by strengthening the prohibition against manufacturers and distributors from selling new vehicles to retail buyers.
