Environmental Matters

State Board of Physician Quality Assurance - Disclosure of Physician's Address of Record

The bill requires the State Board of Physician Quality Assurance to include each licensed physician's designated public address on its list of currently licensed physicians. A physician's designated public address may be a post office box if the physician provides the board with a nonpublic address. The board must maintain the physician's designated nonpublic address on file. The nonpublic address is not a public record and may not be released by the board. The bill requires the board to offer each physician the opportunity to designate a nonpublic address, in addition to a public address, at the time of initial licensure and license renewal. In addition, the bill provides that the board may not release a list of physician applicants for board licensure.

The bill takes effect July 1, 1998.
