Environmental Matters

Health Maintenance Organizations and Managed Care Organizations - Morbidity and Mortality Statistics

This bill requires each HMO and Medicaid managed care organization (MCO) to submit to the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene (DHMH) an annual report on its morbidity and mortality statistics for the immediately preceding year. The bill also directs DHMH to make the report available to the public through appropriate distribution points, including through local health departments.
