## Childhood Lead Screening - Exemption for Religious Beliefs and Practices

This emergency bill provides a religious exemption to the Childhood Lead Screening Program's requirement that evidence of lead screening must be provided from a continuing care health care provider when the child's parent or guardian holds a bona fide religious belief that is in conflict with the program.
