Maryland Medical Assistance Program - Historic Providers - Definition

This bill expands the definition of "historic provider" under the Maryland Medicaid program to include a licensed residential service agency that, on or before June 30, 1995, had a demonstrated history of providing services to Medicaid recipients.

Small Business Effect: Potential meaningful. To the extent that additional small business health care providers may qualify as an historical provider and participate in the Medicaid program under this bill, small businesses would be positively affected.
