Education - Montgomery Community College - Board of Trustees MC 806-98

This bill increases the number of members on the Montgomery Community College Board of Trustees from eight to ten.

This bill takes effect July 1, 1998.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Montgomery County expenditures could increase by \$2,550 beginning in FY 2001 and by \$5,100 annually beginning in FY 2002.

Small Business Effect: None.

Fiscal Analysis

Local Expenditures: The Montgomery Community College Board of Trustees consists of eight members. Board members do not receive a salary, but are reimbursed for board-related expenses. Board-related expenses for travel, meals, and supplies totaled approximately \$20,400 in fiscal 1998 or \$2,550 per member. Two additional board members thus could increase Montgomery County expenditures by approximately \$2,550 in fiscal 2001 when the term of the first new board member begins and by \$5,100 in fiscal 2002 when the term of the second new board member begins.
