#### **Exposure to Contagious Disease or Virus - Notification**

This departmental bill adds several diseases/viruses to the list of contagious diseases/ viruses required to be reported by health care providers to certain personnel who might have been exposed, such as first responders, law enforcement officers, fire fighters, or emergency medical technicians.
