## Washington County - Alcoholic Beverages - Sunday Hours

This bill provides that if Monday is a federal holiday, Class A, Class B, and Class C licensees in Washington County may sell alcoholic beverages on Sunday from 12 noon until 2 a.m. the following Monday. Under current law, alcoholic beverages may be sold on Sunday from 12 noon until 12 midnight.

## **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** None.

**Local Effect:** The additional two hours of alcoholic beverage sales which precede a Monday federal holiday would not directly affect Washington County finances.

**Small Business Effect:** Minimal impact on small businesses.
