## **Child Abuse or Neglect - Disclosure of Information**

This bill authorizes the director of a local department of social services or the Secretary of Human Resources to disclose specified information concerning child abuse or neglect if the following conditions are met: (1) the director or the Secretary determines that disclosure is not contrary to the best interests of the child, the child's siblings, or other children in the household or family; (2) the alleged abuser or neglector has been charged with a crime related to a report of child abuse or neglect; and (3) the child named in a report of abuse or neglect has died or suffered a serious physical injury. It requires that before disclosing the information, the director or the Secretary must consult with each other and the primary law enforcement agency. The Secretary must develop a form for disclosure of the information.
