AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 190, AS AMENDED
(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1 of the bill, in line 15, after the second "Act;" insert "requiring the Governor to include certain appropriations for certain purposes in the State budget for certain fiscal years:".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 10 of the bill, after line 33, insert:

"SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That for fiscal year 2001 and each fiscal year thereafter, the Governor shall include not less than \$21,000,000 in the annual budget in appropriations for activities aimed at reducing tobacco use in Maryland as recommended by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, including:

- (1) Media campaigns aimed at reducing smoking initiation and encouraging smokers to quit smoking;
- (2) Media campaigns educating the public about the dangers of secondhand smoke exposure;
- (3) Enforcement of existing laws banning the sale or distribution of tobacco products to minors;
- (4) Promotion and implementation of smoking cessation programs; and
- (5) Implementation of school-based tobacco education programs."

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 11 of the bill, in line 4, strike "4." and substitute "5.".

In the Budget and Taxation Committee Amendments (HB0190/819428/1), in line 3 of Amendment No. 4, strike “5.” and substitute “6.”.

In Senator Neall’s Amendments (HB0190/813616/1), in line 2 of Amendment No. 2, strike “6.” and substitute “7.”; in lines 7 and 8, in each instance, strike “6” and substitute “7”; in line 10, strike the first “7.” and substitute “8.”; and in line 11, strike “8.” and “7”, respectively, and substitute “9.” and “8”, respectively.
