## AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 190

(Third Reading File Bill)

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 3, after "cigarettes;" insert "providing for the distribution of certain tobacco tax revenue to a certain special fund for certain fiscal years, to be used only for certain purposes;"; and in line 20, strike "12-105" and substitute "2-1603, 12-105,".

## AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 33, insert:

"<u>2-1603.</u>

- (A) [After] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, AFTER making the distributions required under §§ 2-1601 and 2-1602 of this subtitle, the Comptroller shall distribute the remaining tobacco tax revenue to the General Fund of the State.
- (B) (1) FOR EACH FISCAL YEAR THAT BEGINS ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 2000, BEFORE MAKING THE DISTRIBUTION REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, THE COMPTROLLER SHALL DISTRIBUTE \$90,000,000 TO THE DEDICATED PURPOSE FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER § 7-310 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.
- (2) MONEYS DISTRIBUTED TO THE DEDICATED PURPOSE FUND UNDER THIS SUBSECTION MAY BE USED ONLY FOR THE FOLLOWING PURPOSES:
- (I) PUBLIC AND SCHOOL EDUCATION CAMPAIGNS TO DECREASE TOBACCO USE WITH INITIAL EMPHASIS ON AREAS TARGETED BY TOBACCO MANUFACTURERS IN MARKETING AND PROMOTING CIGARETTE AND TOBACCO PRODUCTS; AND

(II) SMOKING CESSATION PROGRAMS.".
