AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 13, after “products;” insert “requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to establish a program to provide nicotine patches and nicotine gum; declaring the intent of the General Assembly with respect to the funding of the program;”.

On page 2, after line 25, insert:

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 10, after line 23, insert:

“Article - Health - General

18-109.

(A) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH A PROGRAM TO PROVIDE NICOTINE PATCHES AND NICOTINE GUM TO ASSIST INDIVIDUALS IN TERMINATING THEIR USE OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS.

(B) IT IS THE INTENT OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY THAT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2001 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE STATE BUDGET FUNDS FOR THE PROGRAM ESTABLISHED IN SUBSECTION (A) OF
