AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 190, AS AMENDED
(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1 of the bill, in line 13, after “products;” insert “requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to make a certain report to the General Assembly by a certain date;”; and in line 15, after the second “Act;” insert “providing for the termination of this Act;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

In Senator Neall’s Amendments (HB0190/813616/1), in line 10 of Amendment No. 2, strike the first “7.” and substitute “8.”; and in line 11, strike “8.” and “7”, respectively, and substitute “9.” and “8”, respectively.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 12 of the bill, before line 1, insert:

“SECTION 7. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene shall report to the General Assembly on or before December 31, 2001 on the effect of the tobacco tax increase on underage smoking.”;

in line 5, after “1999.” insert “It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of June 30, 2002, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.”.
