AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1191

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, before "Procurement" insert "State"; in the same line, strike "- Preferences for Resident Bidders" and substitute "Law - Application to Maryland Port Administration and Modification of the Reciprocal Preference Program"; in line 4, after "process;" insert "exempting the Maryland Port Administration from certain provisions of the State procurement law for limited purposes and for a limited period; providing for the application of certain provisions of this Act;"; in line 5, after "term;" insert "providing for the effective date of this Act; providing for the termination of certain provisions of this Act;"; and in line 6, after "process" insert "and a limited exemption of the certain provisions of the procurement law for the Maryland Port Administration".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 5, after "office" insert "OR OPERATION"; in line 8, strike "STATES" and substitute "STATE"; strike beginning with "A" in line 8 down through "BY" in line 9; in line 10, strike beginning with "ORIGINATES" through "GIVE" and substitute "HAS ITS PRINCIPAL OPERATION THROUGH WHICH IT WOULD PROVIDE SUPPLIES OR SERVICES GIVES"; in the same line, strike the second set of brackets; in the same line, strike "THEIR"; in line 21, strike "STATES" and substitute "STATE"; strike beginning with "A" in line 21 down through "BY" in line 22; in line 23, strike "ORIGINATES OR IS PRODUCED" and substitute "HAS ITS PRINCIPAL OPERATION THROUGH WHICH IT WOULD PROVIDE SUPPLIES OR SERVICES"; in line 29, strike "ANY OF THE STATES" and substitute "THE STATE"; strike beginning with "A" in line 29 down through "BY" in line 31; and strike beginning with "ORIGINATES" in line 31 down through "RESIDENTS" in line 32 and substitute "HAS ITS PRINCIPAL OPERATION THROUGH WHICH IT WOULD PROVIDE SUPPLIES OR SERVICES".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

(Over)

On page 2, after line 32, insert:

“SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

(a) Except as provided in Title 14, Subtitle 3, Title 15, and Title 17, Subtitles 1 and 2 of the State Finance and Procurement Article, Division II of the State Finance and Procurement Article does not apply to the Maryland Port Administration for procurement pertaining to design, construction, or dredging related to a container facility of at least 100 acres at Dundalk Marine Terminal.

(b) Notwithstanding the termination provision under Section 4 of this Act, the exception from Division II of the State Finance and Procurement Article under subsection (a) of this section, shall remain in effect for the term of any contract awarded while the exception is in effect.”;

in line 33, strike “2.” and substitute “3.”; in the same line, after “That” insert “Section 1 of”; and after line 34, insert:

“SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 of this Act shall take effect June 1, 1999. Subject to the provisions of Section 2(b) of this Act, it shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and, at the end of May 31, 2001, with no further action required by the General Assembly, Section 2 of this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.”.
