AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 152

(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with "Vehicle" in line 2 down through "Stickers" in line 3 and substitute "Motor Vehicles - Windshield Materials - Governmental Exemptions"; strike beginning with "creating" in line 4 down through "installations" in line 7 and substitute "requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to adopt regulations to exempt certain government agencies from certain prohibitions against driving a vehicle with certain materials on the vehicle's windshield"; and in line 8, strike "the obstruction of a vehicle driver's view of traffic" and substitute "windshield material prohibitions and exemptions".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 18, strike "paragraph (2)" and substitute "PARAGRAPHS (2) AND (3)".

On page 2, in line 6, strike the brackets; strike beginning with the semicolon in line 8 down through "TRAFFIC" in line 14; and after line 14, insert:

"(3) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO EXEMPT FROM THE PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION MATERIALS PLACED ON THE WINDSHIELD OF A VEHICLE IN COMPLIANCE WITH SECURITY MEASURES REQUIRED BY A FEDERAL OR STATE GOVERNMENT AGENCY AND APPROVED BY THE ADMINISTRATION."
