AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 183

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “and McKee” and substitute “McKee, Wood, McIntosh, Benson, Dypski, Parrott, Malone, Glassman, DeCarlo, Bronrott, Snodgrass, Clagett, Shank, Mandel, Dobson, Paige, Sophocleus, Riley, Bobo, Brinkley, and Swain”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 4, after “appointment” insert “qualifications”; in line 8, after “Commission;” insert “altering the membership of the Commission;”; in line 22, strike “9-915, inclusive, 9-920,” and substitute “9-913, inclusive, 9-915, 9-920,”.

On page 2, in line 9, after “9-908,” insert “9-914,”.

On page 3, in line 13, strike the brackets; and in the same line, strike “§ 9-913”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3, in line 21, after “BE” insert “:

(1) A VETERAN WHO HAS AN HONORABLE DISCHARGE FROM ACTIVE SERVICE WITH A UNIFORMED SERVICE OF THE UNITED STATES; AND

(2)”;

in line 30, strike “NOTWITHSTANDING” and substitute “SUBJECT TO”.

On page 4, in line 7, strike the brackets; and in the same line, strike “SUBTITLE,”.

AMENDMENT NO. 4

(Over)

On page 4, in line 17, strike “26” and substitute “28”; and in lines 20 and 21, in each instance, strike “25” and substitute “27”; in line 24, strike “and”; after line 24, insert:

“(III) 1 SHALL BE A REPRESENTATIVE OF A WOMEN VETERANS ORGANIZATION IN THE STATE; AND”;

and in line 25, strike “(iii)” and substitute “(IV)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 5

On page 5, in line 13, strike “and”; and in line 14, after “Inc.” insert “; AND”

17. THE BLACK VETERANS OF ALL WARS, INC.”.
