AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 5
(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 2, after line 7, insert:

“BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,
Article - State Finance and Procurement
Section 5-7B-01(d)(1)(iii)
Annotated Code of Maryland
(1995 Replacement Volume and 1998 Supplement)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, in line 13, after “DEVELOPED” insert “IN CONSULTATION WITH THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS LOCATED WITHIN THE COUNTY”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3, in line 36, strike “QUALIFYING” and substitute “QUALIFIED”; on page 4, in line 1, strike “QUALIFYING” and substitute “QUALIFIED”; in line 10, strike “QUALIFYING” and substitute “A QUALIFIED”; and in the same line, strike “COUNTIES” and substitute “COUNTY”.

On page 5 in lines 16, 20, 23, 26, 30, 32, 36, and 38 and on page 6 in line 1, in each instance, strike “QUALIFYING” and substitute “QUALIFIED”.

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 4, in line 12, after “BUILDINGS,” insert “INFRASTRUCTURE SERVING EXISTING RETAIL AND OFFICE ORIENTED CENTERS OCCUPYING AT LEAST 400,000 SQUARE FEET ON A LIMITED BASIS OF NO MORE THAN ONE PER JURISDICTION,”.

AMENDMENT NO. 5

On page 4, strike lines 15 through 21 in their entirety; in line 25, strike “FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE” and substitute “LOANS”.

AMENDMENT NO. 6

On page 4, in line 22, strike “(3)” and substitute “(2)”; and in line 30, strike “(4)” and substitute “(3)”.

On page 5, in line 8, strike “(5)” and substitute “(4)”; in line 14, strike “(6)” and substitute “(5)”; and in line 28, strike “(7)” and substitute “(6)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 7

On page 6, after line 19, insert:

“Article - State Finance and Procurement

5-7B-01.

(d) (1) “Growth-related project” means only the items set forth below:

(iii) funding by the Department of Business and Economic Development under any of the following:

1. the Maryland Industrial Land Act, authorized under Article 83A, Title 5, Subtitle 7 of the Code;

2. the Maryland Industrial and Commercial Redevelopment Fund, authorized under Article 83A, Title 5, Subtitle 8 of the Code;

3. the Maryland Industrial Development Financing Authority, authorized under Article 83A, Title 5, Subtitle 9 of the Code;

4. the Maryland Small Business Development Financing Authority, authorized under Article 83A, Title 5, Subtitle 10 of the Code;

5. the Maryland Energy Financing Act, authorized under Article 83A, Title 6, Subtitle 4 of the Code; and

6. the Economic Development Opportunities Program Fund, authorized under § 7-314 of this article;”.
