AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 185, AS AMENDED
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1 of the bill, in line 9, after “assistance;” insert “providing that the Fund is a growth-related project;”; and after line 16, insert:

“BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - State Finance and Procurement

Section 5-7B-01(d)(1)(iii)

Annotated Code of Maryland

(1995 Replacement Volume and 1998 Supplement)”.”

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1 of the Economic Matters Committee Amendments (HB0185/123989/1), strike Amendment No. 1 in its entirety.

On page 2 of the bill, strike in their entirety lines 1 through 3, inclusive; in lines 4, 13, and 17, strike “(D)”, “(F)”, and “(G)”, respectively, and substitute “(C)”, “(D)”, and “(E)”, respectively; strike in their entirety lines 11 and 12; in line 15, strike “SALES” and substitute “REVENUES”; in line 17, strike “(1)”; strike in their entirety lines 19 through 21, inclusive; and in lines 26 and 27, strike “AND ECONOMICALLY DISADVANTAGED INDIVIDUALS” and substitute “BUSINESSES”.

On page 3 of the bill, strike lines 24 and 25 in their entirety; and in lines 26 and 28, strike “(4)” and “(5)”, respectively, and substitute “(2)” and “(3)”, respectively.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 6 of the bill, after line 8, insert:

(Over)

“Article - State Finance and Procurement

5-7B-01.

(d) (1) “Growth-related project” means only the items set forth below:

(iii) funding by the Department of Business and Economic Development under any of the following:

1. the Maryland Industrial Land Act, authorized under Article 83A, Title 5, Subtitle 7 of the Code;

2. the Maryland Industrial and Commercial Redevelopment Fund, authorized under Article 83A, Title 5, Subtitle 8 of the Code;

3. the Maryland Industrial Development Financing Authority, authorized under Article 83A, Title 5, Subtitle 9 of the Code;

4. the Maryland Small Business Development Financing Authority, authorized under Article 83A, Title 5, Subtitle 10 of the Code;

5. the Maryland Energy Financing Act, authorized under Article 83A, Title 6, Subtitle 4 of the Code; [and]

6. the Economic Development Opportunities Program Fund, authorized under § 7-314 of this article; AND

7. THE MARYLAND COMPETITIVE ADVANTAGE FINANCING FUND, AUTHORIZED UNDER ARTICLE 83A, TITLE 5, SUBTITLE 13 OF THE CODE;”.
