(c) Before a license expires, the licensee periodically may renew it for an additional term, if the licensee:

- (1) Otherwise is entitled to be licensed;
- (2) Pays to the Board:
 - (i) <u>A renewal fee set by the Board; or</u>

(ii) <u>A renewal fee that is set by the Board if the licensee certifies to the</u> Board that the licensee provides professional services only as a volunteer; and

- (3) <u>Submits to the Board:</u>
 - (i) <u>A renewal application on the form that the Board requires; [and]</u>
 - (ii) Satisfactory evidence of completion of:

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<u>1.</u> <u>1,000 hours of active nursing practice within the 5-year period</u> immediately preceding the date of renewal;

(III) <u>SATISFACTORY EVIDENCE OF COMPLIANCE WITH ANY</u> <u>CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS SET UNDER THIS SECTION FOR LICENSE</u> <u>RENEWAL.</u>

(D) (1) IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED BY THE BOARD, THE BOARD MAY ESTABLISH CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS AS A CONDITION TO THE RENEWAL OF LICENSES UNDER THIS SECTION.

(2) (I) AS PART OF THE CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED UNDER THIS SECTION, THE BOARD SHALL REQUIRE A COURSE ON THE SPECIAL CARE NEEDS OF TERMINALLY ILL INDIVIDUALS AND THEIR FAMILIES.

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(d) (1) In addition to any other qualifications and requirements established by the Board, the Board may establish continuing education requirements as a condition to the renewal of licenses under this section.

(2) In establishing these requirements, the Board shall evaluate existing methods, devices, and programs in use among the various medical specialties and other recognized medical groups.

(3) The Board may not establish or enforce these requirements if they would so reduce the number of physicians in a community as to jeopardize the availability of adequate medical care in that community.
