AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 206

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 3, after “of” insert “Sunset and”; in line 4, after “of” insert “altering the termination date of the Task Force to Study Increasing the Availability of Substance Abuse Programs;”; in the same line, strike “requiring” and substitute “by which”; in line 5, after “Programs” insert “is required”; in the same line, after “report” insert “; making technical changes; and generally relating to the Task Force to Study Increasing the Availability of Substance Abuse Programs”; and after line 5, insert:

“BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Chapter 778 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1998

Section 3 “.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, after line 12, insert:

“Chapter 778 of the Acts of 1998

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 1 of this Act shall take effect June 1, 1998. It shall remain effective for a period of [1 year] 2 YEARS and [6] 7 months and, at the end of [January 1] DECEMBER 31, 2000, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.”.

On page 3, in line 25, strike “on or”.
