AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike "47th Alcoholic Beverages District" and substitute "<u>46th and 47th</u> <u>Alcoholic Beverages Districts</u>"; in lines 4 and 9, strike "47th Alcoholic Beverages District" and substitute "<u>46th and 47th Alcoholic Beverages Districts</u>"; in line 7, after "annually" insert "<u>at a</u> <u>certain time</u>"; in line 8, after "met;" insert "<u>increasing the required capital investment for licensed</u> restaurant facilities; establishing that certain improvements are not a capital investment; establishing a maximum seating capacity for a licensed restaurant; increasing to a certain percent the amount of average daily receipts that must derive from the sale of food; prohibiting a license from being transferred from the location of its first issuance; prohibiting the issuance of a license to certain restaurants;"; and after line 14, insert:

"BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages Section 6-201(d)(1)(vii) Annotated Code of Maryland (1998 Replacement Volume and 1998 Supplement)".

<u>AMENDMENT NO. 2</u>

On page 1, after line 24, insert:

"(vii) In addition to the other requirements provided for in this subsection, in the 46TH AND 47th Alcoholic Beverages [District] DISTRICTS the restaurant shall have a minimum:

<u>1.</u> <u>Capital investment of [\$250,000] \$500,000 for restaurant</u> <u>facilities not including the cost of the land, [or] THE building, OR IMPROVEMENTS THAT ARE</u> <u>NOT TO THE INTERIOR OF A BUILDING ON THE LICENSED PREMISES; and</u>

2. <u>Seating capacity of 75 persons, AND A MAXIMUM</u> <u>SEATING CAPACITY OF 150 PERSONS.</u>";

and in line 27, after the first "THE" insert "46TH OR".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, in line 1, strike "50%" and substitute "<u>51%</u>"; in line 3, after "ANNUALLY" insert "<u>, AT THE TIME THE LICENSE IS RENEWED</u>,"; and after line 7, insert:

"<u>3.</u> <u>A LICENSE MAY NOT BE TRANSFERRED FROM THE</u> LOCATION OF ITS FIRST ISSUANCE.

<u>4.</u> <u>A LICENSE MAY NOT BE ISSUED FOR USE IN AN</u> ESTABLISHMENT THAT IS A FAST FOOD STYLE RESTAURANT.".
