AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 787

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike "Crime Laboratories" and substitute "Maryland Crime Laboratory Council"; in line 4, strike "and duties" and substitute ", duties, certain meeting requirements, and certain procedures"; strike beginning with "establishing" in line 4 down through the second "Fund" in line 15 and substitute "specifying the terms of the initial members of the Council"; strike in their entirety lines 17 through 21, inclusive; in line 24, strike "18-407" and substitute "18-406"; and in line 25, strike "Crime Laboratories" and substitute "Maryland Crime Laboratory Council".

On pages 1 and 2, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 28 on page 1 through line 1 on page 2, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike in their entirety lines 4 through 22, inclusive; and in line 24, strike "CRIME LABORATORIES" and substitute "MARYLAND CRIME LABORATORY COUNCIL".

On page 3, strike beginning with "'DEPARTMENT'" in line 7 down through "(F)" in line 9; in line 22, after the semicolon insert:

"(6) THE PUBLIC DEFENDER OR THE PUBLIC DEFENDER'S DESIGNEE;";

and in line 23, strike "(6)" and substitute "(7)".

On page 4, strike beginning with the colon in line 21 down through "(1)" in line 22; in lines 23, 26, 28, and 30, strike "(I)", "(II)", "(III)", and "(IV)", respectively, and substitute "(1)", "(2)", "(3)", and "(4)", respectively; and in line 32, strike "; AND" and substitute a period.

On pages 5 and 6, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 1 on page 5 through

line 15 on page 6, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 6, after line 15, insert:

“SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of the initial members of the State Commission on Criminal Sentencing Policy who are subject to appointment shall expire as follows:

- (1) The representative of the Governor’s Office of Crime Control and Prevention in 2001;
- (2) The representative of the crime laboratory of the Department of State Police in 2003;
- (3) The representative of the crime laboratory of the State Medical Examiner’s Office in 2001;
- (4) The representative of the crime laboratory of Baltimore City in 2003;
- (5) The representative of the crime laboratory of Anne Arundel County in 2001;
- (6) The representative of the crime laboratory of Baltimore County in 2003;
- (7) The representative of the crime laboratory of Montgomery County in 2001;
- (8) The representative of the crime laboratory of Prince George’s County in 2003;
- (9) The representative of the crime laboratory of the city of Hagerstown in 2001;
- (10) The representative of the crime laboratory of Ocean City in 2003;
- (11) The representative of the State’s Attorney’s Association in 2001; and
- (12) The judge of a circuit court in 2001.”;

and in line 16, strike “2.” and substitute “3.”.
