AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 858

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 7, after “violations;” insert “defining a certain term; providing for a delayed effective date;”.

On page 2, in line 12, after “ANY” insert “PROHIBITED”; in the same line, strike “WHATSOEVER” and substitute “, AS DEFINED IN § 7-206.2 (G) OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE,”; and in line 14, strike “USE” and substitute “RESALE”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 18, after “(G)” insert:

“(1) IN THIS SUBSECTION, “PROHIBITED COMMERCIAL PURPOSE” INCLUDES ANY USE THAT INVOLVES THE RESALE OR OTHER COMPENSATED TRANSFER OF INFORMATION MADE AVAILABLE UNDER SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION.

“(2) “PROHIBITED COMMERCIAL PURPOSE” DOES NOT INCLUDE THE INCORPORATION OF PORTIONS OF INFORMATION MADE AVAILABLE UNDER SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION INTO DOCUMENTS COMMENTING UPON OR ADVISING PERSONS OF THE LEGAL EFFECT OF THAT INFORMATION, EVEN THOUGH THE PERSON INCORPORATING THE INFORMATION MAY BE COMPENSATED FOR THE COMMENTS OR ADVICE.

“(3)”; in line 19, after “ANY” insert “PROHIBITED”; and in line 23, strike “October 1, 1999” and substitute “January 1, 2000”.
