AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 8

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike "and Kasemeyer" and substitute "<u>Kasemeyer, Currie, DeGrange, Hoffman, Lawlah, McFadden, Middleton, Munson, Neall, Ruben, Stoltzfus, and Van Hollen</u>".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, at the top of the page, insert "<u>EMERGENCY BILL</u>"; in line 10, after "the" insert "<u>retroactive</u>"; and in the same line, after "Act;" insert "<u>making this Act an emergency measure</u>;".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, strike beginning with "take" in line 8 down through "shall" in line 9; in line 10, strike "1998" and substitute "1997"; and after line 10, insert:

"SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted."
