AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 69

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, at the top of the page, insert "EMERGENCY BILL"; in line 10, after "applicant" insert "or the licensee"; and in line 13, after the semicolon insert "allowing the Public Service Commission to use a private agency to provide certain background checks under certain circumstances; clarifying that the Public Service Commission may suspend or revoke a license under certain circumstances; making this Act an emergency measure;".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 26, before "THE" insert:

"(I) IN RESPONSE TO AN APPLICATION FOR AN INITIAL CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORDS CHECK,";

in line 27, strike the colon; in line 28, strike "(I)"; in line 29, strike "; AND" and substitute a period; in line 30, after "(II)" strike "A REVISED PRINTED STATEMENT"; and in line 33, after "CHECK" insert ", THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE INFORMATION SYSTEM CENTRAL REPOSITORY SHALL PROVIDE TO THE COMMISSION AND THE APPLICANT OR LICENSEE A REVISED PRINTED STATEMENT OF THE APPLICANT'S OR LICENSEE'S STATE CRIMINAL RECORD".

On page 3, in line 1, strike "PUBLIC SERVICE".

On page 4, in line 3, after "license" insert "OR SUSPEND OR REVOKE THE LICENSE OF A LICENSEE"; in the same line, after the second "applicant" insert "OR LICENSEE"; and in line 4, after "applicant's" insert "OR LICENSEE'S".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

(Over)

On page 3, after line 32, insert:

“(6) THE COMMISSION MAY USE A PRIVATE AGENCY TO PROVIDE A BACKGROUND CHECK ON AN APPLICANT OR LICENSEE UNDER THIS SECTION, AS DETERMINED BY THE COMMISSION.”.

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 4, strike beginning with “shall” in line 6 down through “October 1, 1999” in line 7 and substitute “is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted”.
