- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 19 (A) A PERSON MAY NOT USE OR POSSESS METHYL METHACRYLATE LIQUID 20 MONOMER (MMA) IN A BEAUTY SALON IN THIS STATE.
- 21 (B) TO DETERMINE WHETHER A PERSON IS IN VIOLATION OF SUBSECTION (A)
- 22 OF THIS SECTION, AN INSPECTOR MAY CHEMICALLY TEST PRODUCTS OR TAKE
- 23 SAMPLES OF PRODUCTS AT RANDOM OR WHEN THE INSPECTOR SUSPECTS THAT A
- 24 PRODUCT IS ILLEGAL.
- 25 (C) (1) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A
- 26 MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE OF \$5,000 FOR EACH
- 27 VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION.

- 1 (2) EACH VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION IS A SEPARATE OFFENSE.
- 2 (D) (1) AN INDIVIDUAL LICENSEE WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS SUBJECT 3 TO IMMEDIATE SUSPENSION OF THE INDIVIDUAL'S LICENSE.
- 4 (2) THE HOLDER OF THE BEAUTY SALON PERMIT FOR THE BEAUTY
- 5 SALON IN WHICH THE VIOLATION OCCURRED IS SUBJECT TO IMMEDIATE
- 6 SUSPENSION OF THE BEAUTY SALON PERMIT.
- 7 (3) BEFORE A LICENSE OR PERMIT SUSPENDED UNDER THIS
- 8 SUBSECTION MAY BE REINSTATED, THE BOARD SHALL HOLD A HEARING ON THE
- 9 VIOLATION.
- 10 (4) FOR REPEATED VIOLATIONS OF THIS SECTION, THE BOARD MAY
- 11 REVOKE A LICENSE OR PERMIT SUSPENDED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION AND MAY
- 12 IMPOSE ADDITIONAL PENALTIES SET BY THE BOARD.
- 13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 14 July 1, 1999.
