## A BILL ENTITLED

## 1 AN ACT concerning

- 2 Creation of a State Debt Anne Arundel County Waterway Improvement Project
- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$1,500,000,
- 5 the proceeds to be used as a grant to the County Executive and County Council
- 6 of Anne Arundel County for certain development or improvement purposes;
- 7 providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that
- 8 the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; and providing generally for
- 9 the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.
- 10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 11 MARYLAND, That:
- 12 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 13 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Anne Arundel
- 14 County Waterway Improvement Project Loan of 1999 in a total principal amount
- 15 equal to the lesser of (i) \$1,500,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided
- 16 in accordance with Section 1(5) below. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance,
- 17 sale, and delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the
- 18 Board of Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117
- 19 through 8-124 of the State Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of
- 20 the Code.
- 21 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as
- 22 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- 23 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 24 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 25 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 26 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then
- 27 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 28 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 29 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the County Executive and County Council
- 30 of Anne Arundel County (referred to hereafter in this Act as "the grantee") for the
- 31 purpose of providing funds, on an installment basis, for the Waterway Improvement

- 1 Project of Anne Arundel County, including dredging operations, sediment removal,
- 2 structural and nonstructural improvements, stream and river bank reconstruction,
- 3 revegetation, erosion control, and the acquisition of property and capital equipment
- 4 for the projects.
- 5 The following segments of the Waterway Improvement Project of Anne Arundel
- 6 County shall qualify for the proceeds of the bonds. Segments 1 through 5 may qualify
- 7 for funding before the effective date of this Act. The proceeds of the bonds for
- 8 segments 1 through 5 shall be available after June 1, 1999.
- 9 The amount specified for each segment and the completion date for each
- 10 segment are estimates only. The amount and completion date for a project are subject
- 11 to change as the scope of a project is made final and an award is made for
- 12 construction or other development of the project.

- An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in 34 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and
- 35 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years
- 36 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 37 (5) (a) The grantee shall provide and expend a matching fund.
- 38 (b) No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either
- 39 directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or
- 40 unappropriated. No part of the fund may consist of real property or in kind
- 41 contributions. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the matching fund may

- 1 consist of funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act for a segment of the
- 2 Waterway Improvement Project of Anne Arundel County. In case of any dispute as to
- 3 the amount of the matching fund or what money or assets may qualify as matching
- 4 funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine the matter and the Board's decision
- 5 is final.
- 6 (c) The grantee shall present evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public
- 7 Works of the provision and expenditure of the matching fund. The Board shall certify
- 8 this fact and the amount of the matching fund to the State Treasurer. The Board of
- 9 Public Works shall disburse the proceeds of the grant under the provisions of this Act
- 10 for the purposes and in the manner set forth in Section 1(3) above. Both the
- 11 presentation of evidence and the disbursement of the proceeds shall be done in
- 12 installments for the segments of the Waterway Improvement Project of Anne Arundel
- 13 County.
- 14 (d) As the grantee provides and expends an installment of the matching
- 15 fund, the Board of Public Works shall disburse an installment of the proceeds of the
- 16 grant equal to the portion of the matching fund presented at that time by the grantee.
- 17 (e) Each installment of the matching fund shall be at least \$100,000.
- 18 (f) This method of presentation of the matching fund in installments and
- 19 of the disbursement of the proceeds of the loan in installments that are equal to each
- 20 presentation of the matching fund shall continue until the first to occur of the
- 21 disbursement of the total amount of the grant or June 1, 2001.
- 22 (g) The grantee has until June 1, 2001, to present the final evidence
- 23 satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that the total matching fund will be
- 24 provided. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact, the
- 25 amount of the final installment of the matching fund, and the amount of the total
- 26 matching fund to the State Treasurer, and the final proceeds of the loan equal to the
- 27 final installment of the matching fund shall be expended for the purposes provided in
- 28 this Act. After June 1, 2001, any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of the
- 29 matching fund certified by the Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of no
- 30 further effect.
- 31 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 32 June 1, 1999.
