- 17 (A) IF AN OBLIGOR FAILS TO COMPLY WITH AN ORDER REQUIRING THE
- 18 PAYMENT OF CHILD OR SPOUSAL SUPPORT, IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER REMEDY
- 19 AVAILABLE, A COURT MAY ORDER THE OBLIGOR TO PAY INTEREST ON THE
