- 4 FOR the purpose of creating in Howard County a Class GC (golf course) beer and light
- 5 wine license; establishing a certain fee for the license established by this Act;

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 15 Article 2B Alcoholic Beverages

- 17 (a) This section applies only in Howard County.
- 18 (b) In this section, "Board" means the Board of License Commissioners.
- 19 (c) The Board may issue A 7-DAY CLASS GC (GOLF COURSE) BEER AND LIGHT
- 20 WINE LICENSE OR A 7-day Class GC (golf course) beer, wine and liquor [licenses]
- 21 LICENSE.
- 22 (d) A license may be issued on behalf of an organization that owns or manages
- 23 a golf course with a minimum of 18 holes.
- 24 (e) The annual license fee is:

- 5 (f) The license is for the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages on the 6 licensed premises.
- 7 (g) The hours and days for sale are found in § 11-514 of this article. However,
- 8 the Board may reduce the hours and days for sale for all or a portion of the licensed
- 9 premises.
- 10 (h) The Board may place conditions on the location of sales and consumption, 11 including:
- 12 (1) Prohibiting the sale and consumption of liquor on specified areas of
- 13 [the licensed] premises WITH A CLASS GC (GOLF COURSE) BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR
- 14 LICENSE; and
- 15 (2) Permitting the sale and consumption of only beer and light wine on
- 16 specified areas of [the licensed] premises WITH A CLASS GC (GOLF COURSE) BEER,
- 17 WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE.
- 18 (i) The Board may restrict the sale of alcoholic beverages to beer and light
- 19 wine ON PREMISES WITH A CLASS GC (GOLF COURSE) BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR
- 20 LICENSE if the Board determines that circumstances warrant.
- 21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 22 June 1, 1999.
