13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

16 8-504.
17 (a) This section applies only in Howard County.
18 (b) In this section, "Board" means the Board of License Commissioners.
(c) The Board may issue A 7-DAY CLASS GC (GOLF COURSE) BEER AND LIGHT 2 WINE LICENSE OR A 7-day Class GC (golf course) beer, wine and liquor [licenses] 3 LICENSE.

4 (d) A license may be issued on behalf of an organization that owns or manages 5 a golf course with a minimum of 18 holes.

6 (e) The annual license fee is:

(1) $\$ 350$ FOR A 7-DAY CLASS GC (GOLF COURSE) BEER AND LIGHT WINE

8 LICENSE; AND

(2) $\$ 1,500$ FOR A 7-DAY CLASS GC (GOLF COURSE) BEER, WINE AND

10 LIQUOR LICENSE.
11 (f) The license is for the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages on the
12 licensed premises.
3 (g) The hours and days for sale are found in § 11-514 of this article. However, 14 the Board may reduce the hours and days for sale for all or a portion of the licensed 15 premises.

16 (h) The Board may place conditions on the location of sales and consumption, 17 including:

18 (1) Prohibiting the sale and consumption of liquor on specified areas of 19 [the licensed] premises WITH A CLASS GC (GOLF COURSE) BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR 20 LICENSE; and

21 (2) Permitting the sale and consumption of only beer and light wine on 22 specified areas of [the licensed] premises WITH A CLASS GC (GOLF COURSE) BEER,
23 WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE.
24 (i) The Board may restrict the sale of alcoholic beverages to beer and light 25 wine ON PREMISES WITH A CLASS GC (GOLF COURSE) BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR
26 LICENSE if the Board determines that circumstances warrant.
27 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 28 June 1, 1999.
