13 (FF) THE PROVISIONS OF § 15-829 OF THE INSURANCE ARTICLE SHALL APPLY 14 TO HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATIONS.

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall apply to all 16 policies, contracts, and health benefit plans issued, delivered, or renewed in the State

17 on or after October 1, 1999. <u>Any policy or health benefit plan in effect before October</u>

18 1, 1999, shall comply with the provisions of this Act no later than October 1, 2000.

19 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 20 October 1, 1999.
