SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 11

12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - State Personnel and Pensions

14 2-512.

A qualifying not-for-profit organization that participates in the Program 15 (c) 16 as a satellite organization shall:

17 (1)pay to the State:

a premium in the amount determined by the Secretary; AND (i)

19 the costs assessed by the Secretary for settlement of claims and [(ii)] 20 expenses resulting from the participation of its employees in the Program; and]

any costs, as determined by the Secretary, for the 21 [(iii)] (II) 22 administration of this Program; and

23 (2)determine the extent to which the organization will subsidize 24 participation by its employees in the Program.
