A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Employee Benefits Program - Satellite Organizations**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing the requirement that certain not-for-profit
4 organizations pay the State certain costs related to participating in the State
5 Employee and Retiree Health and Welfare Benefits Program.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
7 Article - State Personnel and Pensions
8 Section 2-512(c)
9 Annotated Code of Maryland
10 (1997 Replacement Volume and 1998 Supplement)

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - State Personnel and Pensions**

14 2-512.

15 (c) A qualifying not-for-profit organization that participates in the Program
16 as a satellite organization shall:

17 (1) pay to the State:

18 (i) a premium in the amount determined by the Secretary; AND

19 [(ii) the costs assessed by the Secretary for settlement of claims and
20 expenses resulting from the participation of its employees in the Program; and]

21 [(iii)] (II) any costs, as determined by the Secretary, for the
22 administration of this Program; and

23 (2) determine the extent to which the organization will subsidize
24 participation by its employees in the Program.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
2 effect July 1, 1999.
