6 probationary periods in the State Personnel Management System.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - State Personnel and Pensions**

15 7-401.

16 (A) [This] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, THIS subtitle applies to all
17 employees in the:

- 18 (1) skilled service; AND
- 19 (2) professional service [; and
- 20 (3) management service].

21 (B) THIS SUBTITLE DOES NOT APPLY TO AN EMPLOYEE IN:

- 22 (1) THE MANAGEMENT SERVICE; AND
- 23 (2) A SPECIAL APPOINTMENT POSITION IN ANY SERVICE.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
2 October 1, 1999.
