A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Education - Board of Community College Trustees for Anne Arundel**
3 **County - Composition**

4 FOR the purpose of establishing certain criteria for the composition of the Board of
5 Community College Trustees for Anne Arundel County; altering the number of
6 members of the Board of Community College Trustees; and generally relating to
7 the Board of Community College Trustees for Anne Arundel County.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article - Education**

16 16-401.

17 (a) The Board of Community College Trustees for Anne Arundel County
18 consists of [eight] NINE members appointed by the Governor, with the advice and
19 consent of the Senate.

20 (b) (1) One of the members shall be a regularly enrolled student in good
21 standing at Anne Arundel Community College.

22 (2) The student member shall:

23 (i) Be a resident of Anne Arundel County;

24 (ii) Be nominated in the manner determined by the student body of
25 Anne Arundel Community College;

1 (iii) Have the qualifications required to be student body president of
2 Anne Arundel Community College; and

3 (iv) Serve for a term of 1 year, beginning July 1 and ending on June
4 30.

5 (C) (1) ONE OF THE MEMBERS SHALL BE AN ALUMNUS OF ANNE ARUNDEL
6 COMMUNITY COLLEGE.

7 (2) THE ALUMNI MEMBER SHALL:

8 (I) POSSESS AN ASSOCIATE DEGREE FROM THE COLLEGE;

9 (II) BE A MEMBER IN GOOD STANDING OF THE ANNE ARUNDEL
10 COMMUNITY COLLEGE ALUMNI ASSOCIATION; AND

11 (III) OBTAIN THE NOMINATION OF THE ALUMNI ASSOCIATION.

12 (3) THE ALUMNI MEMBER SHALL SERVE A TERM OF 6 YEARS.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
14 October 1, 1999.
