21	A PERSON THAT OPERATES A TOWING SERVICE MAY NOT:
	(1) HAVE A POLICE RADIO IN A TOW TRUCK UNLESS THE PERSON IS PROVIDING TOWING SERVICES FOR A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY UNDER A CONTRACT THAT REQUIRES USE OF A POLICE RADIO;
25	(2) HAVE A SCANNER IN A TOW TRUCK;
